In the matter of Determination of Aeronautical Tariffs in respect of Indira Gandhi International Airport, Delhi with respect to Base Airport Charges, for the Second Control Period (01.04.2014 to 31.03.2019).

1. The Authority vide Order no. 30/2018-19 dated 19.11.2018 determined the tariffs in respect of Indira Gandhi International Airport, Delhi with respect to Base Airport Charges, for the second control period effective from 01.12.2018.

2. Subsequent to the issue of Order, based on the request of Air India and FIA it has been decided to amend/insert the following clauses in the tariff card annexed to Order No.30/2018-19.

ORDER

3. The Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13(1)(a) of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008, and the facts and clarifications placed on record before the Authority, decides and orders that :

i) The clause IV and V of tariff card is amended as follows:

IV) PASSENGER SERVICE FEE (PSF)- FACILITATION

Rate per embarking passenger for ticket issued on or after 01.12.2018

₹ 77 for tickets issued against INR tariff	US\$ 1.93 for tickets issued against foreign currency tariff
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For conversion of US\$ to INR the rate as on the 1st day of the month for the first fortnightly billing period and rate as on the 16th of the month for the second fortnightly billing period shall be adopted.

If the payment is made within 15 days of receipt of invoice, then collection charges at Rs. 2.50 per departing passenger shall be paid by DIAL. No collection charges shall be paid in case the airline fails to pay the PSF (Facilitation) invoice to DIAL within the credit period of 15 days or in case of any part payment.

Rate per embarking passenger for ticket issued on or after 01.12.2018

The collection charges on PSF security shall be payable to airlines as per the extant

Point (1) under the clause VII General Condition is modified as ii)

- 1. The Ministry of Civil Aviation, Govt. of India vide Order No. AV. 29012/2/2002-AAI (Pt.) dated 25th June, 2012 has directed AAI and its lessees to exempt the following category of persons from levy and collection of PSF (Facilitation and Security components).
- Children (under age of 2 years), (a)
- Holders of Diplomatic Passport, (b)
- Airlines crew on duty including sky marshals & airline crew on board for the (c) particular flight only (this would not include Dead Head Crew, or ground personnel),
- Persons travelling on official duty on aircraft operated by Indian Armed (d) (e)
- Persons traveling on official duty for United Nations Peace Keeping Missions. (f)

Transit/transfer passengers (this exemption may be granted to all the passengers transiting up to 24 hrs. "A passenger is treated in transit only if onward travel journey is within 24 hrs. from arrival into airport and is part of the same ticket, in case 2 separate tickets are issued it would not be treated as

Passengers departing from the Indian airports due to involuntary re-routing (g) i.e. technical problems or weather conditions.

The other terms and conditions of the Order No. 30/2018-19 dated 19.11.2018 4. shall remain the same.
